



What are the Notable Wins for Powerball ?

Because the amount of the jackpot that is reported is an annuity consisting of 30 progressive yearly installments, the cash value of the jackpot varies in relation to the annuity. The actual ratio is contingent upon the anticipated interest rates in addition to other aspects. MUSL begins with the cash value, which is constructed from a percentage of sales, and then calculates the announced jackpot amount from that value using the average costs of the three best securities bids. This value is used as the starting point for the calculation.

The head of a construction company in Putnam County, West Virginia, won \$314.9 million (\$474 million now) on December 25, 2002. This was a new record for a single ticket winning an American lottery at

the time. The winner decided to choose the cash option of \$170 million and was awarded around \$83 million after taxes were taken out by West Virginia and the federal government.

A family from Jacksonville, Oregon, won \$340 million (which is equivalent to around \$472 million now) on October 19, 2005. The winners decided to choose a cash payoff of \$164.4 million (before withholdings), which is less than the cash reward that was offered to prior winners in 2002 owing to a modification that had just been made to the annuity structure at that time.

On February 18, 2006, a single ticket purchased in Nebraska won a jackpot that was worth 365 million dollars at the time, which is equivalent to 491 million dollars now. Eight different individuals who worked at the same meatpacking factory used to share it. The company decided to take the cash settlement of about 177.3 million dollars, before taxes and other deductions.

On August 25, 2007, a retired auto worker from Ohio won a jackpot for \$314 million, which is equivalent to 410 million dollars today. The ticket that won the jackpot was purchased in Richmond, Indiana, a city that had previously sold a jackpot-winning ticket worth more than \$200 million.

In November 2011, three finance professionals from Greenwich, Connecticut, split a jackpot of \$254.2 million, which is equivalent to almost \$306 million today. This was the biggest prize ever won on a ticket purchased in the state of Connecticut. After withholdings, the guys decided to go with the cash option and ended up splitting approximately \$104 million. When the drawing took place, the prize was the 12th highest in the annals of Powerball history.

A Powerball ticket purchased in Zephyrhills, Florida, on May 18, 2013, was the winning ticket for the world's highest single-ticket jackpot at the time. The winning annuity was roughly \$590.5 million, which is equivalent to nearly \$687 million today.

[59] Officials with the Florida Lottery made the announcement on June 5 about the winner of the "quick pick" ticket that was bought at a Publix supermarket. [60] The winner decided to choose the cash option, which was about \$370,800,000, before federal withholding. There is no state income tax in Florida since the state does not impose one. [60]

An annuity of approximately \$1.586 billion was split among three Powerball tickets on January 13, 2016, the day after the drawing for the world's largest lottery jackpot at the time. The winning tickets were purchased in Chino Hills, California, Melbourne Beach, Florida, and Munford, Tennessee, and each was worth \$528.8 million.



After deducting what is owed to the federal government, the cash option for each prize comes to \$187,2 million, despite the fact that neither Florida nor Tennessee impose an income tax and California does not tax lottery prizes.

One of the most significant wins in the annals of the lottery's existence was won on August 23, 2017, by the purchaser of a Powerball ticket that was purchased in Chicopee, Massachusetts. The winner took

home more than \$750 million. The fortunate recipient was a woman from Massachusetts who is a mother to two children.

On March 27, 2019, a single ticket bought in Wisconsin was revealed to be the only winner of a \$768.4 million (\$477 million cash) Powerball prize. This jackpot was the third highest in the history of the United States lottery. A guy from Wisconsin who was just 24 years old was found to be the one who had won the big award.

On November 8, 2022, a single ticket bought in California was revealed to be the only winner of a \$2.04 billion (\$997.6 million cash) Powerball prize. This jackpot was the highest in the history of the United States lottery.

The Powerball drawing that took place on March 30, 2005, resulted in 110 people winning the second prize. The total payment to these winners was \$19.4 million, with 89 winners earning \$100,000 apiece and the other 21 winners receiving \$500,000 each as Power Play picks. The total amount distributed to these winners was as follows:

Officials at MUSL originally suspected either fraud or a mistake in reporting. On the other hand, each of the 110 winners had used a number that was printed on a fortune cookie produced by Wonton Food Inc. of Long Island City, New York. On tens of thousands of fortunes, the factory's printing press had printed the digits "22, 28, 32, 33, 39, 40." However, the number "40" in the fortune did not correspond to the Powerball number, which was 42. There was not a single employee of Wonton Food who had such numbers. At that time, Connecticut was the location of the nearest game member. [70] The payments were given since the winners of the tickets had won as a result of a coincidence rather than as a consequence of any illegal activity.

If the fortune cookie had revealed the Powerball number 42, these lucky winners would have split the \$25 million prize, which would have been divided as follows: each \$227,272 annuity or \$122,727 cash (before withholdings). On the cookie was a fortune that said, "All the planning you've done will finally be paying off."

WMS Gaming introduced a variety of slot machines using the Powerball brand name in 2006. These machines debuted in 2006. The Oregon Lottery introduced a Windows Sidebar gadget in 2007, which at the time was capable of displaying the current winning Powerball numbers in real-time. The device also makes statements about the size of the prize.

In 2010, the New York Lottery began selling scratch-off tickets for the Powerball jackpot. The Powerball number and the five winning numbers were printed across the top of the card, and there were 12 different ways to match them. If your numbers were one of the winning combinations, you won the Powerball! The top prize was an annual payment of one million dollars; in contrast to the actual Powerball, there was no option to receive the top prize in cash.
